



Dress Code

For Ag Leadership Program Seminars and Official Events

Updated 12.5.22

The foundation provides the following dress code guidelines related to seminars to ensure clarity and consistency.

We generally select one of two dress codes – business formal or business casual – for the activities on a given day at a seminar. The selection is based on the location, the activity and the person(s) with whom we are meeting.

BUSINESS FORMAL

- A suit with pants and a tie (as appropriate to the suit) or a jacket with a blouse and skirt or dress of reasonable length with comfortable dress shoes.

BUSINESS CASUAL

- A collared shirt (dress or polo) or blouse (dress shirt or sweater set) is recommended. At times, CALF polos will be required at seminars.
- Scarves, blazers and business jackets are always welcome additions.
- Comfortable dress shoes, including loafers, flats and heels.
- Non-jean khakis (beige, brown, green) or darker-colored pants with a belt (as appropriate to the outfit).

Generally:

- Jeans, T-shirts, athletic shoes and flip-flops are not acceptable unless otherwise communicated.
